PROPERTIES

- Ashes 22,30%
- Phosphorus 9,00%

- Magnesium 1,00%
- Sodium 0,90%
- Crude protein <0,30%

DESCRIPTION

Improves the formation and maintenance of the skeleton of the birds, the quality of the skin and integuments , and the hardness of the shell of the egg.

DOSAGE

- **POULTRY MEAT AND PULLETS LAYERS**
From 1 to 3 ml / litre of water during 5 days / month.
If necessary, the dosage could be 5 ml / litre of water during 5 days for technical prescription.
- **LAYERS**
From 1 to 3 ml / litre of water during 5 days / month.
If necessary, the dosage could be 10 ml / litre of water during 5 days for technical prescription.

HANDLING

Well agitate before to use.
To use gloves and protected glasses.

CAUTIONS

Be sure to feed with good transition.
Potable water ad libitum.
No withdrawal period needed.

PACKING

5 and 20 litres drums. Palletized.

EXPIRY

2 years

STORAGE

Store in a dry and fresh place, avoid light and sun. Keep well closed after each use.
Once opened, to use as soon as possible.
